

Kathy's Run is a huge success!

Kathy's Run volunteers announced the total dollars raised as of 8 p.m. the night before the race. That final amount increased to **\$51,000!!!!**

Over 500 people participated in the first-ever Kathy's Run for Pancreatic Cancer Research at Sir Wilfred Laurier Park on October 22, 2011. Many ran and some walked with family members, young and old.

At race time, over \$38,000 was raised for Pancreatic Cancer Canada. That number increased to approximately \$48,000 after race-day donations and finally more than \$51,000. The final totals blew everyone's expectations out of the water. When organizers created the race, they hoped the race would attract 100 participants and raise \$10,000.
